

ePoster Presentation Guidelines

For the Virtual 2021 Meeting, two items will be required to be submitted which together will be a presenter's "ePoster".

1. PDF file of the Poster (similar to what you would create for an in-person meeting)

2. Video file (max. 3 minutes) where the presenter defines their research goals, methods, brief review of results and provides a conclusion

Submission of Presentation

Upload Instructions:

- 1. Save your Poster as a PDF file type with your first and last name (ex. John_Smith.pdf)
- 2. Save your video as an .MP4 file type with your first and last name (ex. John_Smith.mp4)
- 3. Access your unique Speaker's Corner by clicking this link: https://cerealsgrains.confex.com/cerealsgrains/2021/gateway.cgi
- 4. Select your applicable Poster Title next to "Upload ePoster".
- 5. Select the green "Upload ePoster" button near the top of the screen. *You will select this button for each of your items the PDF file and then the video file.

ePOSTER DESIGN

Preparation of a Poster

- The official language for the posters is English.
- Your poster should be self-explanatory so that you are free to supplement and discuss particular points raised by enquiry. It is your responsibility to include the poster title, author(s) name(s), and their affiliations. It may also include:
 - Diagrams and charts
 - Reaction schemes
 - Tables recordings, graphs, etc.
 - Photographs
 - Written text, such as abstract or summary, introduction, method, results, and conclusions
- Some effects that may be used in a poster include:
 - Colors (very effective in diagrams and charts)
 - Transparent overlays
 - Samples of materials, models, etc.
- Arrange the material in main sections, each of them without too many details but with a common thread.

Poster Layout

- Avoid overcrowding figures and cramming too many numbers into tables. Legends and titles should accompany all figures, tables, photographs, etc., for identification.
- Company (including non-profits) or university logos may be displayed in the lower right corner of the poster. No other commercial activity or advertising may be displayed on the poster. Not complying with this rule will result in the poster being removed.

Recommendations

- Font styles: Arial, Verdana, Times or Times New Roman, Garamond, Georgia, Symbols (math equations only)
- Font sizes:
 - Title: sans serif, 48 pt
 - o Subtitles and Section Titles: sans serif, 36 pt
 - Main Text: serif font, 24 recommended, no smaller than 12 pt
- Text design:
 - o Avoid shadow, emboss, engrave, or underline formats for text
 - Keep text horizontal
 - Use several columns
 - Use lines or reasonable gutter spaces between columns
- Image format: .wmf; .jpg; .bmp; .gif; or .tif.
- Image resolution: 300 pixels per inch
