INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBMISSION

Basic formatting

Videos should be in .mp4 or .mov format and should have a minimum aspect ratio of 1280 x 720, with 1920 x 1080 preferred. In general, movies that are made on standard computers and smartphones will meet these requirements.

Infographic or graphical abstract should be in .jpg, .jpeg, .tiff, or .png format.

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ELIGIBILITY

1. A participating student must be one of the following:
 1. a current student member of the Cereals & Grains Association. You can join online at cerealsgrains.org/join.
 2. a current student member of one of the following organizations: Cereals & Europe (C&E), Australasian Grain Science Association (AGSA), or Association of Food Scientists & Technologists - India (AFSTi).
2. A participating early professional must be:
 1. a current professional member of the Cereals & Grains Association. You can join online at cerealsgrains.org/join. And
 2. working in the food industry no more than 5 years from last graduation (regardless of education level, i.e., high school, B.S. B.A., M.S., or higher).
3. Each video must be based on an original idea from the author.
4. Each submission will be the work of the submitting author. Secondary contributors (such as professors) may be consultants, but not a major contributor.
5. To participate in the competition, the author must consent to terms and agreement for use of video. In addition, an infographic or graphical abstract (jpg, jpeg, tiff, png) for use in social media must be submitted with the video.
