- We will be visiting Weihenstephan brewery on Wednesday. Please wear only sturdy shoes (no flip-flops, sandals, heels). Otherwise you will not be allowed to visit the brewery.
- **Those with oral presentations**: Oral presentations are 15 min + 5 min for discussion.
- Please bring your presentation file (PPT or PPTX) on a USB stick driver so that it can be uploaded on the PC before your session
- Those with poster presentations: Posters stands will be available for you during the first day of the workshop. You have to carry your posters with you only on Wednesday.
- At the end of the workshop, everyone will receive a certificate of attendance.
