Guidelines for the Submission of Oral Abstracts

We invite participants to contribute to the **19th European Young Cereal Scientists and Technologists Workshop** (Valencia, Spain, May 25-28, 2020) and submit abstracts for oral presentations. Prior to submitting, please read the submission guidelines below.

General submission guidelines

Abstract submission deadlines: 17 March 2020

Abstracts should be sent to cerealsandeuropa@scisoc.org and fatma.boukid@unipr.it on Cc.

Only abstracts in English language will be accepted.

Please follow the guidelines below:

1. **TITLE:** Type the abstract title in capital letters.
2. **AUTHOR(S)/ INSTITUTIONS:** Enter the names of the authors and respective institutions where the work was done. The presenting author and its email must be indicated.
3. **HIGHLIGHTS:** 3 points to underline the importance of the work (for each point max. 85 characters, no spaces)
4. **ABSTRACT:** Must be submitted in English with the given formatting options in the abstract field. Abstracts texts should not exceed 1200 characters (no spaces).
5. **KEYWORDS:** Enter your keywords (max. 5)
6. **A SHORT BIBLIOGRAPHY:** a paragraph of 250 words to introduce the presenting author

Guidelines for oral presentations

The conference organizers will provide the PC for each session. Please note that the allocated time slot will also include time for discussion. All slides will be presented via Microsoft PowerPoint. Thus, the presentation must be prepared in the format 16:9 as PowerPoint file (.pptx or .ppt). All presenters are required to submit their PowerPoint file well in advance to the organizer. To be on the safe side, please bring your PowerPoint file also on a USB stick with you to the conference.
