William F. Geddes Memorial Lectureship Award

The purpose of the William F. Geddes Memorial Lectureship, sponsored by the AACC International Northwest Section, is to honor the memory of Professor William F. Geddes and advance the profession and practice of cereal chemistry by bringing to Minnesota outstanding persons not normally available to the Section to speak on advances in any aspects of cereal science and technology.

In recent years, the Geddes lecture has also become an opportunity for student involvement and interaction with industry and this year's lecture will continue that tradition. An interdisciplinary student planning committee (composed of food science and nutrition graduate students), under the leadership of Professor Len Marquart, aims to bridge the gap between food science and nutrition disciplines as well as provide opportunities for both undergrad and graduate students to meet and discuss important issues with professionals.
