## Addendum to: Rapid Nephelometric Determination of Alpha-Amylase **Activity in Sprouted Wheat Kernels**

After our article was processed for publication in Cereal CHEMISTRY (56[1]:43-44, 1979), we were informed by the manufacturer of the nephelometer (Perkin-Elmer Corporation, Oak Brook, IL) that the use of an amylopectin substrate in the system allows an indiscriminate determination of both  $\alpha$ -amylase and  $\beta$ -amylase

A  $\beta$ -limit dextrin substrate has recently become available (Perkin-Elmer Corporation) that permits selective measurement of  $\alpha$ -amylase activity. Supporting data will be presented in a forthcoming publication.

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
